Vineyards are located on both sides of the Gironde River, which flows through the region. Red Bordeaux wines are generally made from a blend of grapes; Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, Malbec and Carmenere.

Bordeaux - Left Bank

The most prestigious Appellations are located in the Haut-Medoc AOP, home to some of the world's most distinguished and iconic producers of Cabernet Sauvignon based blend wine, enshrined in the famous 1855 Classification of Bordeaux. Commissioned by Emperor Napoleon III, this Classification ranked the top Bordeaux properties, categorized by price into first through fifth growth.
